2. Statement of Need

Approval is sought for Beyond Visual Line of Sight (BVLOS) operation of military Unmanned Air Systems from Keevil Airfield, an MOD aerodrome in Wiltshire. In order to operate from Keevil a Temporary Danger Area (TDA) will be required, connecting the airfield to the existing Salisbury Plain Danger Area EG D123. This TDA is required in order to increase flying output to the levels necessary to complete essential training to deploy on future operations.

Altitudes affected: SFC – 3500ft AGL

Proposed submission date: Monday 7th September (for 90 days)
