In the initial Statement of Need, a TDA connecting the ATZs of Newquay and St. Mary's airports was considered to carry out UAV BVLOS operations. However, after an initial safety assessment and engagement with airports and operators in the area, a decision has been made to carry out these flights between Land's End Airport and St. Mary's airport, thus making the TDA much shorter and significantly reducing both air and ground risks.

The Isles of Scilly (IoS) are an archipelago off the southwest of Cornwall with a Population of about 2500 people and economy mainly based on tourism.

Commercial transport between mainland England and these Isles is achieved by sea and air. These services are owned by one company and their frequency varies depending on the season.

An opportunity has arisen to trial freight air transport services connecting St.Mary's Airport and Land's End Airport with the use of Unmanned Aircraft Systems . Given the current regulatory and technological conditions , these flights require the provision of a segregated volume of airs pace between the ATZs of both airports .

The proposed TDA would allow for a temporary segregation of the traffic of unmanned aircraft within a "tunnel" inside the current Land's End Corridor, which is used by commercial flights and GA aircraft for transiting to and from the IoS.

This project is partially funded by Cornwall Development Company through their Aerospace program with the objective of increasing the size and capability of the local aerospace and space clusters and securing ongoing investment in them.

Ultimately, the provision of freight transport services between IoS and mainland England using UAVs would have the following benefits :

- Deliver affordable wider options of freight services for organisations and individuals in the IoS.
- Safe environment to carry out UAV BVLOS operations with very reduced impact in current air traffic.

- Real data to support the creation of permanent airspace changes and the Safety Case for carrying out these operations commercially.

- Chance to generate investment and qualified job opportunities in Cornwall.
