25 MAY 2020 – 5 JUNE 2020

1. Introduction

- 1.1 From the 25 May through to the 5 June 2020, a Remotely Pilot Aircraft System (RPAS) will operate between Lorn & Islands Hospital in Oban and Mull & Iona Community Hospital in Craignure on Isle of Mull, both situated in Argyll and Bute, to carry out operational flights for the purpose of transporting essential medical (non-dangerous) goods between the two healthcare sites to assist the NHS Scotland and government response to the COVID-19 pandemic.
- 1.2 The RPAS has no Detect and Avoid (DAA) capability and will be operating Beyond Visual Line of Sight (BVLOS) in wholly Class G airspace. In the absence of a suitable DAA system, such flights are required to operate within segregated airspace. A Temporary Danger Area (TDA) is required to facilitate safe operation. See charted at Figure 1.

2 Timings

- 2.1 Multiple flights are scheduled to take place. Actual times of TDA activation will be promulgated by NOTAM
- 2.2 Due to operational reasons, less than 24 hours' notice may be provided for the activation of the required TDA
