These documents look fine to me and can be published on the portal – please take this email as confirmation that the minutes are approved.

Two minor points for your consideration below that I noticed when reading through the engagement document (rewording of para 2.2 to remove repetition of stakeholder engagement, and you see to have lost the reference to section 6 in the track change in para 2.3) .

2.2 Approach

Skyports intends to proactively encourage aviation stakeholder engagement participation in the stakeholder engagement process by emailing them directly and calling by phone if necessary (especially if there is no email available), to generate as much feedback on our airspace change proposals as possible. We will inform potentially affected stakeholders directly in addition to using intermediaries, like representative bodies, where appropriate.

2.3 Stakeholder identification

Skyports aimed to identify all aviation stakeholders within a 10-mile radius of our route that might have been impacted positively or negatively by the proposed changes, no matter how small the impact. See 6. Stakeholders
