At present the ATZ being H24 is representative of operations and that being said:

- 1. All UK AIP charts that depict Fairford MATZ indicates "Fairford MATZ, Brize Norton 119.0" It does not state hours of operation which is indicative of H24.
- 2. Per the Fairford-Brize Norton Letter of Agreement dated April 2021, para (3) "Brize ATC shall advise Fairford Tower (when open) of all known air systems requesting to transit the RAF Fairford Military Air Traffic Zone (MATZ, see Attachment 1) or when within 5 NM of RAF Fairford at or below 3300 ft Fairford QNH (MSL)." and para (4), b, "During periods when Fairford Tower is not open, Brize ATC will assume control of the Fairford Air Traffic Zone (ATZ) and will not authorize over flights of the airfield below 500' AGL to the maximum extent possible". These two statements indicate the MATZ is monitored by Brize Norton H24
- 3. Removal of the note (NOTAM requirement) does not alter how the airspace is currently monitored (H24) or utilized.
- 4. As a supplement advisory to notes published on charts, during periods of inactivity or in the event of Fairford Tower closure, we will broadcast via the ATIS an advisory to pilots to contact Brize Norton 119.0 for ATZ/MATZ transition service.
