5	RAF Fairford ACP	RAF Fairford / briefed by , DAATM	gave the brief on the enablement of RPAS Operations ACP at RAF Fairford. Secretaries note: The slides are available at ANNEX C including the Statement of Need, Process, Timeline, and contact details. ■ as UK/USAF ATC liaison supported. ■ reiterated that engagement throughout the process would be key. In response to questions ■ confirmed that the air systems have lighting and IFF capability, but that the method of utilisation would be confirmed as part of the process. In response to discussion with ■ confirmed that the speed of the process was influenced by the operational requirement. In discussion surrounding the use of DAA, ■ highlighted that he would like to see a real appetite for the use of DAA and integration, rather than using segregation and airspace as the method of operation. It was also highlighted by ■ that the airspace picture in the UK is much more congested and complex with less available space than in the US. ■ confirmed that the appetite was there for the use of DAA, raising the example of technology being in use and approved by the FAA, confirming that establishing what was acceptable here was a difficulty. ■ also confirmed that the desire was there to minimise the effect on other airspace users, operating between sunset and sunrise and operating above 7000" being cited as examples of mitigation. ■ asked that perhaps a further ACTION may be necessary for engagement policy wise. ■ also raised the question of representation, as well as the quantifying of effects on civil aviation. ■ commented that with there being multiple ACPs in process, there needs to be a coordinated process of liaison	

			established. This was agreed as an action for \/DAATM going forward that engagement with the CAA and feedback on policy be conducted throughout the process. In response to questions from \ and GA representatives asking about the design of the airspace and its restrictions/dimensions, \ confirmed that the USAF are designing the airspace. \ stated that it was too early in the design process to give exacting details, and that questions of procedure were not under the ownership of DAATM; that airspace users/owner/controllers would establish procedure.
