CAELUS (Care & Equity - Logistics UAS Scotland) is project comprised of 14 consortium partners, part funded by the UK Industrial Strategy Future Flight Challenge Fund. AGS Airports, which owns and manages Aberdeen, Glasgow and Southampton airports, is leading the consortium that will develop and trial what will be the UK's first national distribution network to use drones to transport essential medicines, blood, organs and other medical supplies throughout Scotland.

The project is to demonstrate how drone technology can enhance access to essential medical supplies via a drone delivery network connecting hospitals, pathology laboratories, distribution centres, airports and GP surgeries across Scotland.

One aspect of the project is to understand how UAS operations can be integrated with commercial airport operations inside Controlled Airspace whilst ensuring minimal operational impact on the current airspace users and ATC whilst maintaining existing levels of safety. Once the appropriate procedures and associated safety assurances are developed, the intention is to demonstrate a small number of BLVOS flights between Glasgow Airport and an off-aerodrome location within the Glasgow CTR.

The demonstrations are scheduled to take place on a single day in Q2 2022. No changes to the existing notified airspace structures are envisaged necessary for the trial which will be wholly contained within existing Controlled Airspace Boundaries.
