Thank you for the invitation to the additional stage 2 briefing on 23rd January which attended for the Chilterns Conservation Board.

CAP1616 requires that specific attention is given to tranquillity of National Parks and Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONBs). Given the proximity of the Chilterns AONB to RAF Northolt, and the potentially affected area covering the central Chilterns (see map overleaf), we are disappointed that the design principles agreed at Stage 1 do not include a principle referring to the AONB, and if we had been consulted in Stage 1 we would have made representations to this effect.

Even though the agreed Design Principles for RAF Northolt do not give any weight to minimising overflight of the Chilterns Area of Outstanding National Beauty (CAONB), we note and welcome your verbal commitment at the briefing on 23rd January that the options appraisal stage will take full account of the existence and status of the Chilterns AONB as required by CAP1616. In particular that the environmental assessment will include "Explicit consideration of any changes to routes and/or traffic patterns that may affect either an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) or a National Park, with specific regard to impacts upon tranquillity" (p155 of CAP1616 Edition 3); and that the selection of options will have due regard to the Government's altitude-based priorities set out in para B29 of that document, which includes routes avoiding overflight of an AONB below 7000ft when practicable.

We request that you make this commitment to us now, in writing. This is both for clarity, and to ensure that it is carried forward into the options appraisal process.

We believe that the list of options being appraised should not have automatically excluded potential "sharing" of routes with Heathrow or Luton. Accommodating fully independent suites of routes for multiple airports in such close proximity is likely to involve spreading of routes over a larger volume of airspace in a way which does not represent an efficient use of the capacity of that airspace, and Northolt's low volume of traffic arguably does not justify its own dedicated suite of routes.

Subject to, and only subject to, the above provisos, we agree with the approach being taken to develop route options.

Great weight should be given to minimising over-flying of the Chilterns AONB. The opportunity of airspace change process should be taken to re-prioritise the AONB and re-organise airspace to reduce overflying of the AONB and improve the tranquillity of one of the country's finest landscapes and a nationally important visitor destination. Over 10 million people live within an hour's travel of the Chilterns AONB, and over 55 million leisure visits are made to and within the

Chilterns AONB every year. Peaceful leisure time should be recognised as important; the consideration is not only noise over where people live, but where they recreate. Flightpaths should take account of where people visit for leisure time and when people are more likely to be outdoors in the Chilterns AONB. The highest numbers of visitors to the Chilterns AONB are found at weekends and holiday periods, so respite at those times would benefit more people enjoying outdoor activities.

One of the special qualities of the Chilterns AONB defined in the Chilterns AONB Management Plan 2019-24 is "tranquil valleys". The Chilterns AONB Management Plan places a high degree of emphasis on conserving and, where necessary, restoring tranquillity, see policies DP1, DP2 and in particular Policy DP14. Policy DP14 covers aviation, as follows:

"Policy DP14. Avoid new or upgraded infrastructure (roads, railways, airports, pylons, masts etc.) which harm the AONB landscape, nature, air quality, tranquillity or the visitor experience. Fully assess impacts on the AONB, including increased recreation pressure, traffic, overflying and severance of ecological connectivity in the AONB. Avoid, mitigate and compensate to achieve a net gain for the AONB."

The need for tranquil outdoor space is greater than ever. Your future plans should show noise contours and show regard to the tranquillity of the AONB.

The Countryside and Rights of Way Act 2000 imposed a duty on public bodies to have regard to the special qualities of Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty when undertaking their activities (see Appendix 2). The MoD, CAA and airport operators are covered by that statutory duty.

Recommendations

In summary, we are looking for your airspace change plans to have regard to the AONB. We would welcome airspace changes being designed to provide a quieter, cleaner, greener, more tranquil Chilterns AONB than the existing situation.

We ask that you confirm in writing that the options appraisal stage will take full account of the existence and status of the Chilterns AONB as required by CAP1616. In particular that the environmental assessment will include "Explicit consideration of any changes to routes and/or traffic patterns that may affect either an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) or a National Park, with specific regard to impacts upon tranquillity".

We welcome your future continuing engagement with the Chilterns Conservation Board to do this

Appendix 1: About the AONB



The Chilterns Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty

Areas of Outstanding Natural Beauty are designated by the Government for the purpose of ensuring that the special qualities of the finest landscapes in England and Wales are conserved and enhanced.

The Chilterns AONB was designated in 1965 for the natural beauty of its landscape and its natural and cultural heritage. In particular, it was designated to protect its special qualities which include the steep chalk escarpment with areas of flower-rich downland, woodlands, commons, tranquil valleys, the network of ancient routes, villages with their brick and flint houses, chalk streams and a rich historic environment of hillforts and chalk figures.

The map below shows the boundary of the Chilterns AONB in green.

Chilterns Conservation Board

The Chilterns Conservation Board is a statutory independent corporate body set up by Parliamentary Order in 2004 under the provisions of Section 86 of the Countryside and Rights of Way (CROW) Act 2000.

The Board has two statutory purposes under section 87 of the CRoW Act:

- a) To conserve and enhance the natural beauty of the AONB; and
- To increase the understanding and enjoyment by the public of the special qualities of the AONB.

In fulfilling these roles, if it appears that there is a conflict between those purposes, Conservation Boards are to attach greater weight to (a). The Board also has a duty to seek to foster the economic and social well-being of local communities within the AONB.

Like all public bodies, including ministers of the Crown, local authorities and parish councils, the Chilterns Conservation Board is subject to Section 85 of the CRoW Act which states under "General duty of public bodies etc"

"(1) In exercising or performing any functions in relation to, or so as to affect, land in an area of outstanding natural beauty, a relevant authority shall have regard to the purpose of conserving and enhancing the natural beauty of the area of outstanding natural beauty."

RE: London Borough of Harrow Response to RAF Northolt ACP Stage 2 Engagement

Thank you for the opportunity to comment on the RAF Northolt Consultation, which relates to the Airspace Change Proposal Stage 2 Information Brief provided across multiple events in June 2022. The information briefing provided relevant information under Stage 2A of the CAP1616 process, which sets out Design Options. The consultation of the Design Options being developed is to seek feedback on if these are being brought forward in accordance with the Design Principles, which were consulted on in June 2019 which formed Stage 1 of the consultation.

The location of the London Borough of Harrow in relation to RAF Northolt, is directly off the eastern end of the runway, which as a result all aircraft landing from the east will be required to overfly Harrow residents (to line up for approach). For take-off of aircraft towards the east, regardless of if aircraft make a left or right turn (or indeed no turn at all), will also overfly Harrow residents. Approach and take-off in a westerly direction will not result in the London Borough of Harrow being overflown.

Having reviewed the presentation and the information briefing documents please find the following comments on behalf of the London Borough of Harrow.

The information in the presentation primarily sets out the updated flight path options from the east and the west of the runway, with options in terms of approach / departure routes. Whilst the options are able to be understood in terms of potential new people being overflown (Design Principle 7a (and potentially Design Principle 7b/c)), there is little information to provide assurance that Design Principles 1 – 6 have been applied, and that the Design Options would be in alignment with those Design Principles. Further information in relation to Design Principles 1 – 6 would be required to be satisfied that the Design Options have been applied satisfactorily.

Specifically, London Borough of Harrow had previously made an observation (June 2019 information briefing) relating to the use of modern radar equipment being operated at RAF Northolt, which would enable much more specific approach lines to the runway from the East. A modernisation of the radar equipment may allow revised safeguarding zones to be progressed which would provide more certainty for development opportunities within Harrow. Currently, safeguarding zones provide a significant constraint to development opportunities within Harrow, especially in the current climate of housing pressures faced more widely. For

this reason, it is unclear that the proposed options would be designed in alignment with Design Principle 4.

Wider Environmental Impacts

In September 2019 the London Borough of Harrow declared a Climate Emergency, with the aim to make Harrow a carbon neutral borough by 2030. Whilst this declaration is focused on actions within the remit of Harrow Council and its residents and businesses, the matters in relation to this are far more reaching. Furthermore, Harrow is committed to working with partners across London to reduce carbon emissions. For this reason, Harrow would expect that the RAF Northolt proposals (in accordance with Design Principle 6) takes meaningful steps in mitigating climate change, with specific regard to minimising fuel and greenhouse gases. The information briefing document does not clearly set out how this would be achieved.

Conclusions

Planning Policy Manager

The London Borough of Harrow understands and supports airspace modernisation, and support the process of CAP1616. However, support is dependent ensuring the Design Principles are applied to all of the Design Options phase (and beyond).

Harrow Council's primary aim must always be to secure the best possible outcomes for our residents and businesses. The above comments are provided to illustrate the concerns that the Proposed Options have not addressed satisfactory from a Harrow perspective, specifically in relation to impacts on noise, modernisation of equipment (radar), and the wider environment / climate change matters. The Council look forward to subsequent consultation opportunities when further detail is available on such matters as above, and the Council would be able to better consider its position and provide a more comprehensive response.

ROYAL AIR FORCE NORTHOLT AIRSPACE CHANGE PROPOSAL – RESPONSE TO HARROW COUNCIL

Thank you for your letter dated 14 July 2022, in which you have responded to the RAF Northolt Stage 2A Design Options engagement presentation. RAF Northolt conducted engagement sessions throughout June 2022 to present the extensive work that we have conducted in the development of our Design Options, as part of the CAP1616 Airspace Change Proposal process. As part of the process, we elected to send the PowerPoint Presentation Slidepack PDF to all invited stakeholders, to ensure that those that could not attend were provided with an opportunity to read through our presentation materiel. We acknowledge that without the engagement context of the brief accompanying the slides some explanations may seem less clear.

The purpose of the presentation was to demonstrate how RAF Northolt has designed its future airspace options in accordance with its ACP Design Principles, agreed in Stage 1 of CAP1616. This includes, but is not limited to, ensuring future overflights have as little impact as possible in terms of noise on local communities. This must, however, be taken into consideration alongside our other Design Principles. To assist with the points that you have raised in your letter, I have added some context to explain our Design Principles 1-6 in further detail, and how we will be assessing our Design Options against them:

DP 1 – Must be safe. This is an essential Design Principle for RAF Northolt. All illustrative lines presented were designed in accordance with Performance Based Navigation (PBN) standards and although full rigour is not required at this stage of the programme, we are able to say that they are safe in isolation. As the programme progresses full rigour and Safety Assessments will be conducted as required.

DP 2 – Must ensure continuation of Military and Governmental operational activity. This is an essential Design Principle for RAF Northolt. This includes the requirement to allow arrivals and departures to continue in a manner similar to today, that will allow for this DP to be met.

DP 3 – Should minimise impact on other airspace users. Although the illustrative lines and the options are comprehensive, we aim to be cognisant of the other airspace users that

could be affected. For example, one of the slides indicates the ATZ at Denham Aerodrome and show options that try to avoid this area.

DP 4 – Should facilitate design using modern navigational technology. The illustrative lines that are presented within our design options are based on Performance Based Navigation (PBN) which utilises satellite navigation and is currently the most modern method of designing Instrument Flight Procedures. All the options are being designed to utilise PBN, which is a modernised version of the existing flight paths which are based on older, 'conventional' navigation. This will allow aircraft to fly on more specific flight paths during both departure and approach from/to RAF Northolt. These new flight paths could result in updates to safeguarding maps although it is too early to understand what those changes would be. Please note this project is not seeking to update Northolt's radar equipment.

DP 5 – Should facilitate operational efficiencies to maximise benefits to as many stakeholders as possible. Operational efficiencies covers a wide range of considerations. We have focused on the impact of delaying aircraft within this DP. Considerations such as Continuous Climb & Descent Operations, CO2 and impact on other airspace users are addressed by other Design Principles.

DP 6 – Should minimise fuel and greenhouse gases. RAF Northolt is committed to designing options that meet this DP as well as meeting the Govt's Airspace Modernisation Strategy (CAP 1711), which articulates a known outcome 'improve environmental performance by reducing emissions and better managing noise'. RAF Northolt's ACP has many interdependencies with neighbouring major international airports, and we will be working closely with these airports to understand the cumulative benefits/impact across this programme to improve the impact on the environment. Some of the options that are being explored to best address this design principle are Runway 07 Arrival Option 3, Runway 07 Departure Option 3, Runway 25 Arrival Option 3 and Runway 25 Departure Option 4. If feasible, such options would greatly reduce track miles and CO₂ emissions.

RAF Northolt's DPs 1 and 2 are weighted in that order however, DPs 3 – 7 are equally weighted and therefore there will likely be compromises to achieve the best overall outcome.

In the Design Principle Evaluation, which is currently taking place, RAF Northolt will highlight how each of the options presented in the PowerPoint responds to each individual Design Principle. This will allow you to see in more detail how the options either meet, partially meet or do not meet all the different design principles.

I hope that this has answered the points raised in your letter.

Although RAF Northolt Stage 2 Engagement is now complete, more detailed engagement on the RAF Northolt ACP, including Design Options will take place in the next stage of the programme (Stage 3) when formal consultation will take place. I am certain that Harrow Council will fully engage with that further consultative stage and of course the views of the Council will be considered alongside those of other stakeholders throughout the remaining consultative phases.

I would like to take the time to provide a response to your feedback raised on the RAF Northolt ACP Stage 2 Information Brief Feedback Form.

Your comment was as follows:

"NERL is content with the approach which has been taken however we have observed possible missing elements in the swathes. We would like to suggest either a widening of the swathe depicted on page 34 or additional swathes north and south of that option to ensure that maximum flexibility for design development and the deconfliction of routes between different sponsor ACPs is taken forward into Stage 3."

The reason that option exists is just to minimise newly overflown populations and minimise fuel/Greenhouse gases (straight in from LAM). The population is so high either side of the swathes and it's not routinely overflown so any routes in there would not meet any of the DPs without knowing the direction of flight from the stack-

We will make it clear in our Stage 2 documentation that we are not excluding any movement outside of the swathes in Stage 3 if necessary (for example to be operationally viable or reduce CO2) but at this stage, it would not be optimal to our DPs and process if we widened the swathe based on retaining flexibility for Stage 3 alone when we don't know where the Easterly Heathrow stack would be. The swathes are not a constraint but are based on where our routes would be preferable based on the DPs and what we know at this time.


However, if NATS are able to give us an indication now that this route may not be viable, we can add in an additional route within a wider swathe but we need to know where you think that should go Our DPE and IOA will naturally reduce the number of flight path options within each swathe but, again, we will articulate it is all subject to change.
