Dear Stakeholders,

The CAA decided on 17 June 2022 to approve ACP-2021-048 and the temporary activation of TDA EG D597 for specific Large Force Exercises. CAP2362 (*Final Regulatory Decision*) was published and uploaded to the Airspace Change Portal on 27 Jun 2022 [this link](#) provides the exacting details.

Stakeholders are invited to note that activations of TDA EG D597 are requested as per the below:

**March 2023:** 8 daytime activations: 6, 8, 10, 14, 16, 20, 22 and 24 March between 1000 – 1400 UTC.

***The Sponsor would like to propose the below as an amendment to CAP2362 (noting that the number of activations is now 6 – compared to the 8 initially requested).***

**July/August 2023:** 2 night-time activations and 4-day time activations on the following dates: 20 and 25 July (0800 – 1200 UTC), 8 and 10 August (1930 – 2330 UTC), 15 and 17 August (0800 – 1200 UTC).

***September 2023 (dates tbc)*** This is expected to consist of up to 12 activations of up to 4 hours over a 3-week period.

If required a pre and post exercise virtual discussion can be offered to any stakeholder. Requests should be made to the Sponsor. We acknowledge the specific regulatory requirement to collate, monitor and report to the CAA on the level and contents of feedback/complaints associated with the temporary airspace arrangements. All engagements will be documented and shared via the Airspace Change Portal.

*Feedback regarding all activations and any safety or operational concerns should be sent in writing (via email) to the address at the head of this letter. Safety concerns raised by any stakeholder or through the Defence Air Safety Management System will be immediately elevated through the Duty Holder System where a decision regarding the continuation of the exercise will be considered.*
