





#### Radio transcript for 21 RNAV

London Biggin Hill airport is consulting on the modernisation and implementation of a new 'Instrument Approach Procedure' for aircraft arriving at London Biggin Hill Airport. Simply put – an Instrument Approach Procedure is a procedure a pilot can fly when the weather does not allow the pilot to fly visually, due to cloud or when the visibility is low.

The airports current system for this procedure uses ground-based radio beacons which are reaching the end of life, so will no longer be available. The consultation relates to the introduction of a new system which will use satellite technology.

The change purely relates to how aircraft navigate, not where they fly, so there will be no discernible difference noticed from the ground.

The consultation runs from Monday 11th September to Monday 9th October 2023. You can visit <u>www.bigginhillairport.com/airspace-change</u> to learn more and have your say.
