We are in the process of an airspace change proposal (ACP) to the CAA, which would facilitate access for Protector to RAF Marham as the nominated diversion airfield. The proposal has progressed to Stage 3, Consult, whereby the public and wider community are invited to comment on the airspace proposed (key aviation and local authority stakeholders have already been contributing through engagement at all stages of the proposal to date).



By way of introduction, I am part of the team working on the Protector airspace integration that you may recall involved some airspace change above RAF Waddington. The programme now requires additional airspace to access RAF Marham as a diversion airfield. QinetiQ have been contracted to continue the airspace work and we are part-way through the Airspace Change Proposal. We are about to enter Stage 3, Consult, whereby the proposed airspace design and supporting information is published in the public domain to inform stakeholders and invite feedback.

As was the case with Waddington, a press release will be necessary to ensure appropriate reach to all affected stakeholders. For Waddington, a press release was distributed to local media outlets, including local TV, radio, newspapers etc., together with posts on the local social media platforms (RAF unit & ISTAR HQ Facebook/Instagram pages), advertising the proposal and the means by which to obtain further information and submit feedback. A reminder should also be distributed via the media half way through the consultation period (the whole period is 8 weeks). 

You might recall our conversation a few weeks ago, ref the press release at the mid-point of the consultation phase for the permanent DA Airspace Change Proposal (ACP) over Marham. I may well have missed it, but could you please forward the evidence of those press releases distributed at the beginning of July.

In addition, for your awareness, we have been instructed to commence engagement regarding an ACP in the vicinity of Holbeach AWR by means of a Temporary Danger Area (TDA), also for protector ops. The anticipated airspace implementation is spring 2025.

Similar to the Marham airspace, this is likely to evolve into a proposal for permanent airspace, whereby a public consultation will be necessary (although this will not be for quite a few months yet). We are advised that Holbeach does not have a designated MCO and that the RAFLO would be most appropriate contact for us to liaise with. 



Good afternoon,

By way of introduction, I ampart of the team working on the Protector airspace integration that you may recall involved some airspace change above RAF Waddington. The programme now requires additional airspace to access RAF Marham as a diversion airfield. QinetiQ have been contracted to continue the airspace work and we are part-way through the Airspace Change Proposal. We are about to enter Stage 3, Consult, whereby the proposed airspace design and supporting information is published in the public domain to inform stakeholders and invite feedback.

RAF Marham Airspace Change Proposal Consultation Period

On the 11th of June 2024 a consultation period will begin for an airspace change proposal in the vicinity of RAF Marham.

The airspace change will enable Protector RGMk1, a large Remotely Piloted Air System (RPAS), to access RAF Marham as a diversion airfield.

The purpose of this consultation period is to provide an opportunity for all stakeholders, including the general public, to comment on the proposed airspace design. This feedback will be collated and analysed by the Change Sponsor and help to shape the final proposal that will be submitted to the Civil Aviation Authority (CAA).

In accordance with UK regulation, this consultation will be undertaken through electronic communication.
